



KCP Registration and Transcripts

Registration

In the KCP program you will be concurrently enrolled and registered in a full course of study (18 quarter credits or 15 quarter credits for the Summer Short-term program) for each quarter that you are studying abroad. You will be registered in a block of International Studies credits. These credits are graded Satisfactory or Unsatisfactory. WWU allows S/U graded courses to be used for major and minor requirements as the minimum requirement for a Satisfactory grade is a "C-". Other Universities may transfer S/U grades in a different manner, so it is strongly advised that you check with your home institution to determine how these grades will transfer.

Please note that S/U graded courses may not be taken as Pass/Fail and may not be audited.

For Fall, Winter, Spring, and Summer quarters:

KCP Japanese Level 1 or 2:	International Studies 205 (18 credits)
KCP Japanese Level 3 or 4:	International Studies 305 (18 credits)
KCP Japanese Level 5 or 6:	International Studies 405 (18 credits)
KCP Japanese Culture & Civilization:	International Studies 305 (4 credits)

For Summer Short-Term:

KCP Japanese Level 1 or 2:	International Studies 205 (15 credits)
KCP Japanese Level 3 or 4:	International Studies 305 (15 credits)
KCP Japanese Level 5 or 6:	International Studies 405 (15 credits)

Please note that the Culture & Civilization course is not available to Summer Short-Term students.
